What you need:

What to do:

1. Have your students participate in a docent-lead Texas History Tour at *The Hall of State*.
2. Ask the students to brainstorm 2-3 *new* things that they learned during the tour.
3. Ask the students to brainstorm 2-3 things that they liked the best about the tour.
4. Have each student write a “Thank You” Letter to the docent(s) that took them on the Texas History Tour.
5. Have each student incorporate what they learned and liked best about the Texas History Tour in their letters to their docent(s).

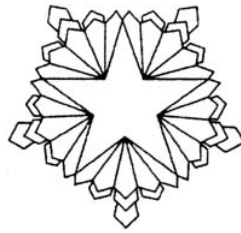
